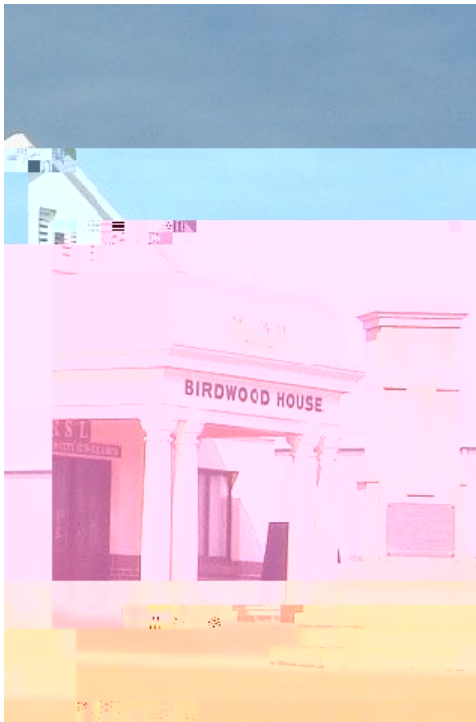

The war memorial, erected at the same time as Birdwood House, was constructed of granite from the Darling Ranges. Along the lines of a Cenotaph, the memorial stands 4.25m high, on a base 3.25m x 2.4m x 0.6m and was hewn from a single block of granite weighing over 3 tonnes
