<p>This timber framed weatherboard clad house has a metal ("timdeck") gambrel roof with a separate gable roof to the front (west) elevation. The main roof extends to cover a verandah which is hipped to the north. There are tuned timber supporting posts to the verandah which has lattice infill with a low fibro balustrade below. The gable end has fibro and timber batten infill with a mini orb awning to the window. Windows are timber framed and double hung. There is a brick corbelled chimney to the rear.</p>

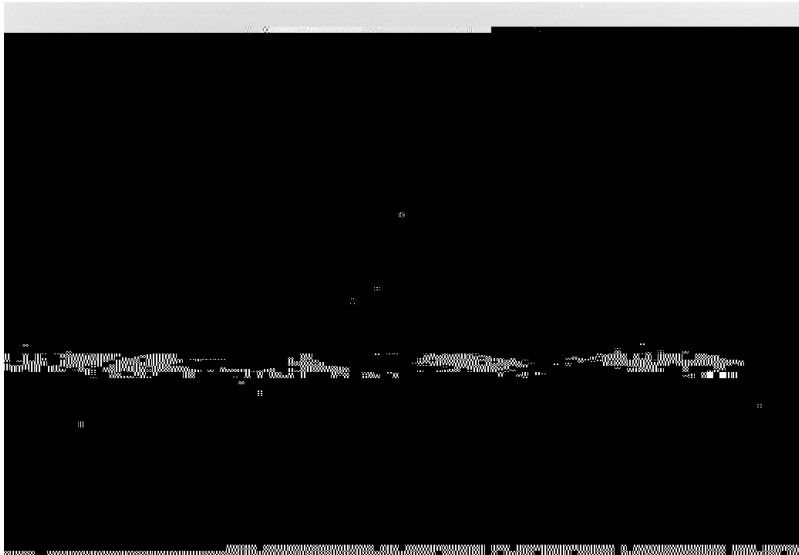
