This former church has a steeply pitched corrugated iron gable roof with a small gable to a porch to the front elevation. The building is clad with weatherboard to half height with fibro above. The gable end has a slatted timber framed air vent. Windows to the sides are timber framed casement style. The front facade of the porch has three narrow arched timber framed windows. There is an extension to the rear built in sympathetic style. The front of the property is bounded by a picket fence which is inset to provide parking.

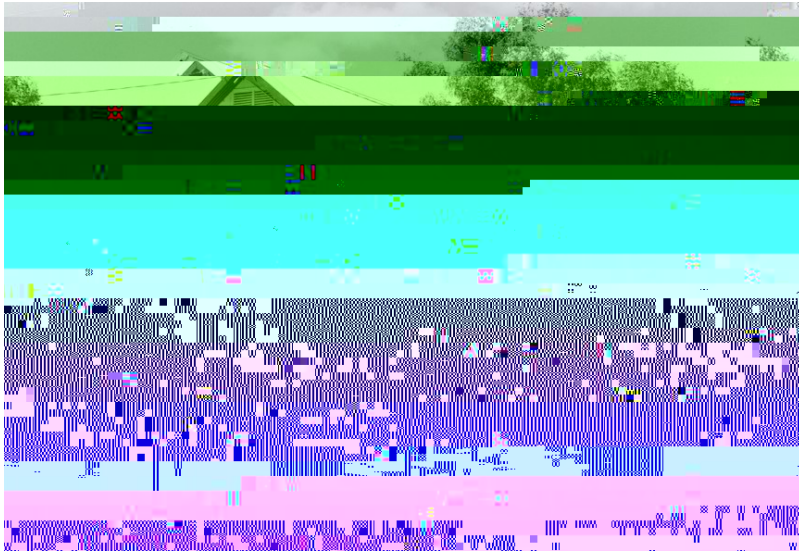
