This small timber framed weatherboard clad cottage has a gable corrugated iron roof with a skillion roof to the rear and a separate verandah roof to the front. The front verandah is supported on timber posts with a fibro balustrade to one half and fibro infill to the other and the verandah ends. The verandah is accessed via timber steps with timber handrails. The property has a stone clad

This small cottage is representative of the simple cottage style of its era. While the original cladding to the house has been retained, infill has been used on the front verandah. The place contributes to the streetscape of the area.
