This house was demolished in c1998. The following description is taken from the 1997 City of Geraldton Municipal Inventory: This small timber framed cottage is clad with weatherboard to the front and corrugated iron to the sides. The corrugated iron gambrel roof has a lean-to roof to the rear and a separate bull nose verandah roof to the front. The verandah roof is supported on timber posts with a simple timber balustrade. Windows are timber framed and casement style. There is a metal chimney to the south and a timber framed corrugated iron clad shed to the rear.

This small weatherboard cottage was representative of vernacular housing of its era. The bullnose verandah style and weatherboard cladding gave the place some charm which added to the streetscape of the area.
