Located on the west bank of the Greenough River, McCartney Cottage consists of the original limestone structure which has been added to with red stone to form an 'L'. The cottage has a hipped corrugated iron roof which is punctuated by a tall brick corbelled chimney. There is a lean-to masonry roof to the rear which is enclosed with fibro sheeting. In recent times a brick addition has provided a large living area, while there is a small concrete block extension to the south. Pergola has been added to the west and a car port is attached to the north elevation.
