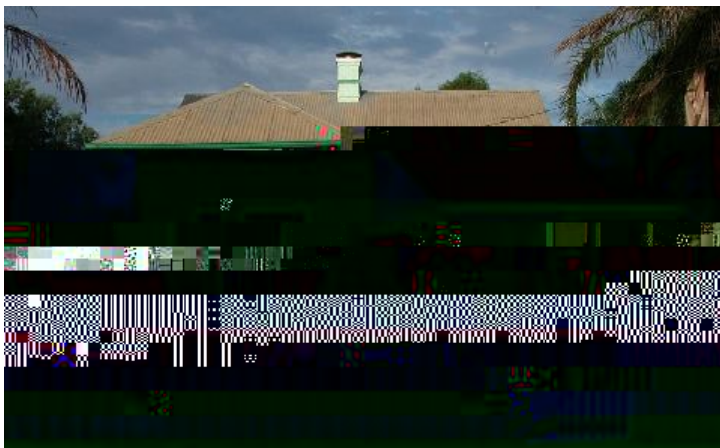

93 Carr Street has significance as evidence of later settlement patterns of the Greenough district through the introduction of railways, in particular, the Geraldton-Mullewa line and the increasing importance of Namgulu as a railway settlement. The place is also one of only a few original weatherboard houses in the Shire.
